Preparatory Year

HSE's Preparatory Year trains international students with little or no knowledge of Russian before they begin Russian-taught Bachelor's and Master's programmes. Students improve their basic language skills, study in a chosen academic field (humanities, economics, or engineering), and adapt to the new educational environment. Upon completing Preparatory Year, students are expected to possess intermediate-level language skills (CEFR level B1, TRKI level 1) and be ready to study in Rus-sian-taught full-degree programmes at HSE and other Russian universities.



Doing Business in Russia
