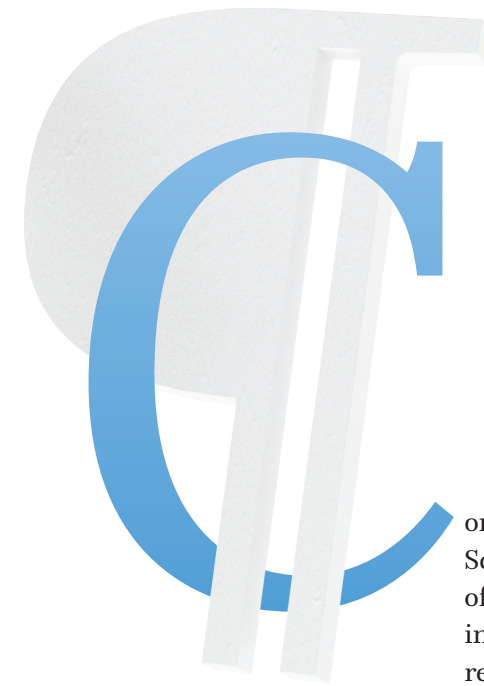

The Higher School of Economics was established in 1992 as the first Russian institution with international academic standards to train economists for the post-Soviet economy. Its first faculties were management, sociology, political science, humanities, world economy, and international relations.

With the addition of the Moscow Institute of Electronics and Mathematics in 2011, HSE became a centre of training for experts in electronic engineering, telecommunications, computer security and space technology.

Together with Yandex, a top Russian IT company, HSE launched a faculty of computer science, where students focus on programme engineering, data analysis and artificial intelligence and address new challenges in the areas of big data systems and information search.

HSE's recently established Faculty of Physics will enable students to carry out research not only at HSE laboratories, but also in several leading institutes of the Russian Academy of Sciences (RAS).

The HSE Vysokovsky Graduate School of Urban Studies and Planning is the first of its kind in Russian higher education and the only research and education centre in the country that trains specialists in the spatial development of cities and regions.

# Our Campuses



## Moscow

HSE's founding campus was established in 1992 in the historic Kitai-Gorod neighbourhood of Moscow. Today, HSE's urban campus is spread across the city, offering students the opportunity to explore its unique neighbourhoods, museums, and many historic sites. HSE Moscow enrolls about 22,000 students in a variety of programmes, including English-taught undergraduate, graduate, and summer programmes, across its different faculties. ## St. Petersburg

St. Petersburg is the cultural heart of Russia, known as Peter the Great's "Window to the West." The HSE St. Petersburg campus opened in 1998, and is located in the historic centre of the city, near landmarks such as the Hermitage and the Russian Museum. ## Nizhny Novgorod

HSE's campus in Nizhny Novgorod was established in 1996. A UNESCO World Heritage City, Nizhny Novgorod is a leading industrial and scientific centre, and home to five universities and nearly 100 research institutions. ## Perm

Located near the Ural Mountains and the border of Siberia, Perm is a rapidly growing city that is home to a number of museums, theatres, and new art galleries. Perm was previously a "closed city" due to its Soviet labour camps and weapons factories. ### Bachelor's-level Programmes

Undergraduate students at HSE come from all over Russia – and the world. They enjoy:

- **Individualized education plans**  
Students can choose for themselves up to a third of the courses required for their majors, taking advantage of the freedom to pursue broader interests. They can also choose from a pool of over 50 minors, with each minor comprising four inter-related courses.
- **Strong academic support and assistance**  
Academic mentors help students to design their curricula and support them in their project work and research.
- **Active engagement in project work and research**  
One-fifth of all degree programmes consists of project work, so that students gain maximum experience and exposure, while enjoying full access to HSE's extensive academic research resources.
- **In-depth English language study**  
All undergraduate students take an English language exam at the end of their second year. This ensures that they will be fully able to study in English-taught courses at HSE and partner universities abroad. 21% of all courses at HSE are taught in English. Dual-degree Bachelor's programmes through the International College of Economics and Finance and the Faculty of World Economy and International Affairs are also conducted in English.

## Master's-level Programmes

Upon completion of HSE Master's programmes, graduates are well positioned to launch their professional careers or continue onto doctoral programs.

Opportunities for graduate students:

- Access international internships and student exchanges
- Study in double-degree programmes with leading foreign universities
- Work as a paid research assistant or instructor
- Conduct research at HSE's laboratories and institutes

HSE has the largest number of state-funded places for Master's programmes in Russia. A large number of full-tuition merit-based scholarships are awarded to international students.

## Doctoral-level Programmes

Doctoral programmes at HSE meet international standards in providing specialized training and extensive research opportunities for degree candidates. Joint PhD and cotutelle programmes are available for outstanding students. Employment opportunities are available at HSE research units. Students consult with an international co-advisor and perform an obligatory internship at one of HSE's international partner universities.

Russian government scholarships are available for international students who wish to enrol in HSE doctoral programmes. There are also short-term academic mobility opportunities.

## Faculty

At the heart of our academics are more than 7,000 HSE instructors and researchers devoted to supporting and developing our students' knowledge and research. Outside the classroom, our faculty members participate in internationally-recognized research and are regularly published in top journals. HSE provides generous funding for faculty research and conference travel.

HSE is the first Russian state university to recruit international faculty members. These scholars, graduates of leading international research universities, serve as full faculty members, researchers, and heads of our international research laboratories. They currently account for 6% of all faculty members, which makes HSE the leading Russian university in this respect.

## International Programmes

HSE offers educational programmes in English at all levels of education for international students. Each year, the university enrolls more than 900 international students for full-degree graduate and undergraduate programmes from more than 60 countries in the CIS, North America, Europe, Asia, and beyond. In addition, international visiting and exchange students can earn credits through studying at HSE's Semester in Moscow or St. Petersburg and Summer University programmes. Each year, a one-week Winter School is held to give prospective students an introduction to study at HSE.

Professional development programmes, such as Doing Business in Russia, are also available for both international students and businesses.

Russian language training is made available to international students year-round through HSE's Centre for Russian as a Foreign Language, which offers electives during the semester and an intensive summer school.

HSE's Preparatory Year is a foundation course offered to international students who wish to study in HSE's Russian-taught full-degree programmes but lack the necessary language skills. Over 10 months of intensive study, students improve their basic language skills, study in a chosen academic field, and adapt to the new educational environment.

HSE holds International Olympiad Competitions for high school students, as well as for university students and graduates. The Olympiads are held in different countries and their winners and runners-up are given priority when applying to HSE Bachelor's and Master's programmes.

HSE's International Admissions Office and International Students Office provide support for international students on a wide array of issues, from visa processing and living accommodations to course selection and cultural activities.

HSE is a leader in online education among Russian universities.

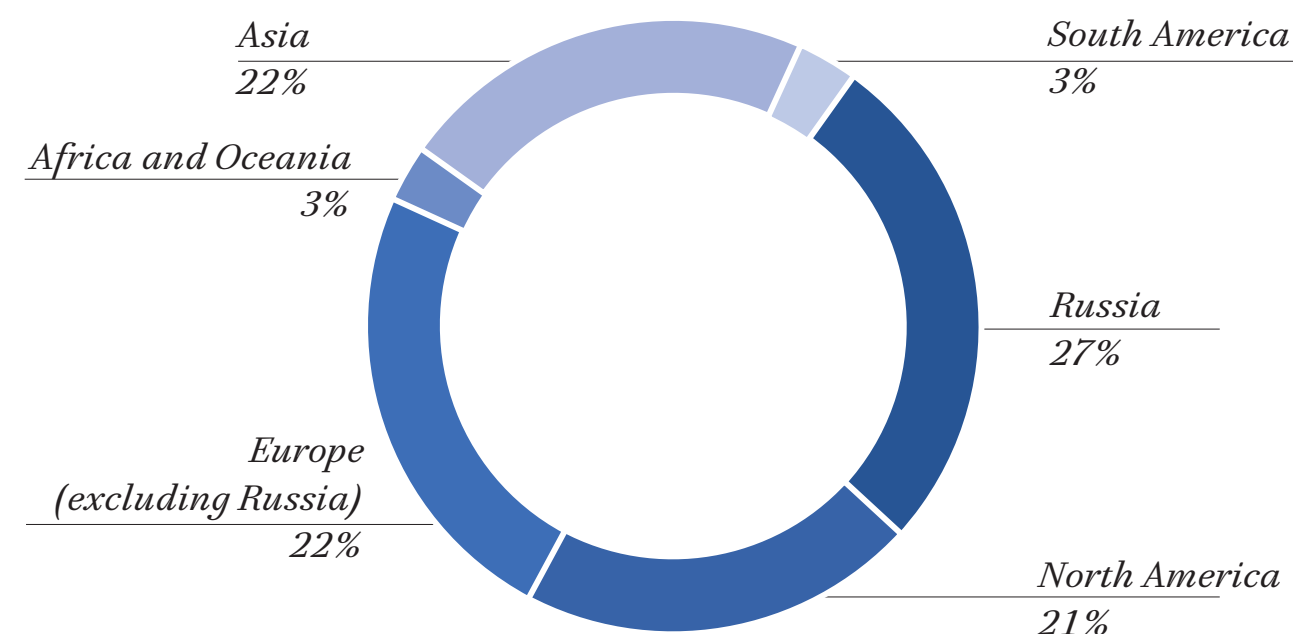
Courses taught by the best HSE instructors are available free of charge on Coursera and the Russian National Open Education Platform. Since 2016, participants in HSE's courses on the National Open Education Platform have had the opportunity to receive an official certificate confirming their attendance.

In addition to separate courses, HSE also offers three specializations organized as sets of consecutive courses with a practical component. One of the specializations, Data Structures and Algorithms, is delivered in English jointly with the University of California, San Diego.

## Giving Back

### Russia Longitudinal Monitoring Survey-HSE

The Russia Longitudinal Monitoring Survey - Higher School of Economics (RLMS-HSE) is a series of nationally representative surveys designed to monitor the effects of Russian reforms on the health and economic wellbeing of households and individuals in the Russian Federation. These effects are measured by a variety of means: detailed monitoring of individuals' health status and dietary intake, precise measurement of household-level expenditures and service utilization, and collection of relevant community-level data, including region-specific prices and community infrastructure data. Data have been collected 22 times since 1992.

RLMS-HSE is conducted by HSE and ZAO Demoscope together with the Carolina Population Center at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, headed by Barry M. Popkin and the Institute of Sociology RAS.

### Basic Research

HSE is committed to supporting and developing the basic research essential for its international presence. The Basic Research Programme supports the implementation of large-scale integrated research and aims to unite research and the education process. The majority of projects concern institutional analysis, economic and technological development, education, health care, social welfare, social values, civil society, and the labour market.

### Applied Research

HSE is one of the largest research and innovation centres in Russia, with research models based on global experience and in-house basic research. HSE has a demonstrated track record of commercializing research, developing forecasting technologies, and cooperating with government institutions and leading domestic and foreign research centres, universities, and companies. Over the past five years, HSE has completed over 1,500 projects and has contributed to the development of seven Russian government programmes and 13 federal programmes.

### Monitoring Studies

HSE's research centres conduct a number of innovative monitoring studies that are used by government agencies, the business community, and academia. More than ten large-scale monitoring studies are conducted annually; studies are published in monographs and leading academic journals, as well as on the HSE website.

International engagement has been intrinsic to HSE's mission since the university's inception. The scope of this activity has rapidly grown over the past two decades and continues to increase. HSE is a national leader in international faculty recruitment and has pioneered the process for Russian universities to incorporate scholars who hold western PhDs. The number of HSE's English-taught programmes has increased from two in 2010-11 to 30 in 2017-18.

## ICEF-University of London Double-Degree Programme

Since 1997, ICEF (HSE's International College of Economics and Finance) and the London School of Economics and Political Science (a part of the University of London) have offered a unique double-degree

Bachelor's degree programme. Students study primarily in English for four years and graduate with a Russian degree from HSE and a British degree from the University of London.
